TEACHING KIDS ABOUT MONEY—ONE PUMPKIN AT A TIME

Fall means sweaters, apple cider, and of course... pumpkin picking! But a trip to the pumpkin patch can also be the perfect chance to sneak in a little financial lesson for your kids.

Picture this: You arrive at the patch with rows of pumpkins in every size and color. Instead of simply letting your child grab the biggest one, hand them a small "pumpkin budget"—say \$10—and let them take charge.

As they wander, they'll quickly realize they have choices:

- A giant pumpkin might take their entire budget.
- Two smaller pumpkins could stretch their money further.
- Or maybe saving a few dollars leaves room for a caramel apple or cider donut later.

Suddenly, the pumpkin patch becomes a classroom. They're practicing decisionmaking, comparison shopping, and opportunity cost—all while having fun.

You can take it a step further by encouraging them to:

- Weigh options: Is the biggest pumpkin worth it, or would two smaller ones bring more joy?
- Think long-term: A pumpkin they can carry might be the better choice.
- Save a little: If they don't spend the full \$10, talk about saving for another treat or outing.

At the end of the day, your child gets the pumpkin they chose, and you get the satisfaction of knowing you gave them a

real-world money lesson-without it ever feeling like school. And years from now, when they're managing bigger budgets, they'll remember these small but meaningful lessons.

THANKSGIVING FUN AROUND THE TABLE

After the turkey's carved and the mashed potatoes have made their rounds, what's left? Sometimes, a food coma. But this year, why not keep the conversation lively and laughter flowing with a few easy Thanksgiving table games?
