IRS IMPERSONATION SCAMS : If you get a call or email demanding immediate payment or threatening arrest, it's a scam. The IRS will always contact you by mail first and never ask for payment via gift cards or wire transfers.

SHADY TAX PREPARERS: If someone promises an unusually large refund or bases their fee on your refund amount, be cautious! Only trust licensed professionals with your tax return.

Your best defense? Stay informed, verify sources, and never share personal details with unverified contacts. Protect your finances this tax season!
